


"Dr. John Arango, ND, CAS a clinical researcher and is double board certified as an Alternative Medical

Practitioner by the American Alternative

Medical Association since 2006 and an Autism Specialist by the International Board of Credentialing and Continuing Education Standards.

Dr. Arango works with adults and children with developmental



challenges to maximize their potential for growth, learning, and independence by evaluating diet, lifestyle, and environmental factors as well as physical, emotional, and mental factors.

Specialized physiological, biochemical, and metabolic assessments, including laboratory tests, brainscans, and psycho-social studies used in

developing clinical intervention strategies will be discussed during Dr. Arango's presentation.
